

Color-Changing Water Bottle

Cleaning Instructions

Due to the stainless steel material of this bottle, water may take on a slight metallic taste. The bottle is food safe and the taste will reduce over time and use. The taste can be minimized by first washing your bottle with baking soda or citrus juice.

Step 1

Remove the bottle's cap and set it aside. Pour 2 tbsp. Bicarbonate Of Soda into the bottle.

Replace the cap and shake the bottle. This spreads the soda over the interior surface.

Step 2

Take the cap off again and, leaving the Bicarbonate Soda inside, add warm water (not boiling) until the bottle is 1/2 full and shake the bottle again vigorously. Now fill the bottle to near the top with warm water, give it another little shake and leave to soak overnight.

Step 3

Pour the contents out and rinse the inside of the bottle. Place a small amount (1 tsp. or less) of Bicarbonate Soda on a soft cloth. Wipe down inside and outside of the mouthpiece with the cloth; then rinse bottle under warm water.
